Vaccination Update

We are continuing to take bookings for booster shots, and we are pleased to now be starting paediatric vaccinations in Ouyen.

As with all our vaccination arrangements, please register your interest, and we will get in touch to book you or your child in when spots are available.

Our vaccination clinics are currently limited by supplies and staff availability, but we are doing vaccinations as quickly as possible. If you are keen to obtain a booster or paediatric vaccination earlier, appointments are available at Sunraysia Community Health in Mildura, Swan Hill District Health and at pharmacies.

Loddon Mallee vaccination team has confirmed it will visit **Murrayville** on Australia Day **January 26** and **Underbool** on **January 27** for paediatric vaccinations only.

Visits To Aged Care

Please continue to call ahead to arrange visits to residents at our aged care facilities.

We're doing our very best to arrange visits where possible, but with increasing community transmission of COVID-19, our priority is to keep our vulnerable residents safe. Reducing the number of visits to our facilities reduces the risk of COVID-19 entering our facilities.

Restrictions currently allow two visitors per day for each resident, with visitors required to wear N95 masks, which will be provided by MTHCS.

When you visit you might also be asked to take a Rapid Antigen Test on arrival.

Children are welcome to have window visits and as always we are happy to arrange catch ups on the phone and with an I-Pad where that's a good option.
