Gastroenteritis Outbreak In Victoria

Please be aware that there has been a rapid rise in outbreaks of viral gastroenteritis in Victorian childcare centres.

Infants or children, as well as staff, who develop vomiting or diarrhoea should not attend childcare, camps or any other group activities until at least 48 hours after their symptoms have stopped.

Symptoms can take up to three days to develop and last between one or two days or longer.

They include nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, fever, abdominal pain, headache and muscle aches. If symptoms are severe or they persist, or you are concerned, book in with the GP for advice or testing.
