Concern over new COVID-19 infections in Victoria

Health authorities are warning COVID-19 infections could rise significantly over coming weeks as the Omicron BA.4/BA.5 strain spreads through the community. The Department of Health anticipates the prevalence of BA.4/BA.5 in Victoria is likely to result in an increase in cases - including reinfections - and hospital admissions and deaths. This is because the strain has a greater ability than the previous BA.2 strain to evade immunity provided by vaccination and earlier COVID-19 infection. Staying COVID-safe and well this winter

MTHCS is encouraging everyone to look after their health as the winter cold hits the region. To protect yourself and your loved ones, please remember to:

- Remain up to date with your COVID-19 vaccines. COVID-19 vaccines (including booster shots) are available through our medical clinics. Please phone to discuss your appointment.

- **Get your flu shot.** These are also available through our medical clinics, so please phone to make an appointment.
- Stay home if you feel unwell. This is a simple but effective way to help stop the spread of COVID-19, the flu and winter colds. If you have COVID-19 symptoms, you should get tested. If you test positive, you must isolate for seven days.
- Wear a face mask in shared indoor settings, if you can't physically distance or you are with those more vulnerable to COVID-19.
- Improve ventilation by opening doors and windows, using fans or purifiers, and gathering outside where possible.
